**Visibility/Location:** You can definitely spot this street from 22nd pretty easily, since all of the props and decorations are outdoors and there are many cars parked along the streets there-- you should have no problems finding it.

**Wait Entertainment:** n/a. This was a free show for anyone who wants to go through it (although they accept donations via donation boxes).

**Length of Event:** As long as you want to spend looking at the "freaky frights". I think it took us about 20-30 minutes to walk up and down the 2 blocks of scenery.

**Actor Performance:** n/a--no actors were out tonight/Tuesday night, but I think they do occasionally have people hiding here and there to scare the people walking by.

**Patron Flow Inside Attraction:** n/a--there were a lot of other people viewing the scenes/props, though.

**Appropriate Ages:** pretty much any age, but some of the props were gruesome

**Props / Special FX:** awesome, like last year. I don't know how they animated so many of their props, but they were very creative with their setups (like the dresser drawers that opened and closed)

**Costumes / Make-up:** n/a

**Summary:** This is a fantastic, \*free\*, event that families and individuals can visit this Halloween with plenty of entertainment just in walking through their Halloween prop displays. Most homes on Forest participated in this, with their yards full of creative and fantastic displays. Everyone that we passed by seemed to really enjoy viewing these displays and I personally loved it. There seems to be so much to look at and the homeowners had no problem with people taking pictures of the prop displays and even posing with them (there was a mock guillotine that my boyfriend posed in!). I'd definitely recommend stopping by this even if you have some free time this Halloween season!

Scare Factor: Very Low | Atmosphere: Good 

**Visibility/Location:** Easy to find following their directions from the website. I honestly can't remember if they had any signs posted, but you can see all of the lights and cars parked along the adjacent streets pretty easily.

**Wait Entertainment:** there was no wait--you walk along the streets and up and down the sidewalks to see their Halloween props and decorations

**Length of Event:** it took us about a half hour to walk the whole thing

**Actor Performance:** there weren't any actors out tonight

**Patron Flow Inside Attraction:** everyone walks around at their own pace and a lot of people took their time to admire the props

**Summary:** We had a lot of fun seeing all of the props and decorations and were really impressed with how complicated some of the displays were. More than half of the houses along the two blocks of this street had some amazing displays, ranging from the creature in Jeepers Creepers (my favorite), to a volcano scene, to a psychedelic neon moving ghoul. Most props were animated and a lot were motion activated so that did seem to catch the younger kids that were walking by off guard. We saw people going to the Freaky Frights of all ages, so I think this attraction would be okay for any age. They also had security guards standing by which I think made a lot of people more comfortable going to this event. Given that this event is free to see, I'd recommend it to all!
